From Our President

Judaism emphasizes gratitude, study, prayer, and a love for *Eretz Yisrael*. Ours is a positive religion. During these days of awe, we are solemn but not gloomy. We reflect, but we also look forward. From our long history we know that buried in every setback lies the seed of a golden opportunity.

We have much to be grateful for as we begin 5771. *Todah Rabah* to the volunteers providing professional leadership of our Torah School and Hebrew School. Education VP, **Nancy Zimmerman**, is guiding the school along a successful path. **Adele Stein** as lead teacher, and veterans of the CKI school, **Sue Johnson** and **Barb Razowsky**, are providing strength and continuity. New members of the education committee are lending new ideas. Teacher and parent representation on the Education Committee ensure a strong Jewish foundation for the children of CKI as they prepare to become *Bar & Bat Mitzvah* and continue through Confirmation. CKI teachers continue to be compensated. From a significant and painful budget cut, a vibrant volunteer driven education program is blossoming.

Supplementing the formal youth education is CKI's vibrant USY group. Guided by **Liza Bachrach**, the outstanding achievements of the Elgin based USYers are recognized by the leadership of the USCJ Midwest region.

The men of CKI recently spent two Sundays repairing, dusting, and generally maintaining our building. *Todah Rabah*. Last Sunday the required number of people arrived to transform our sanctuary into the ethereal ambiance we are experiencing today. Our synagogue has the amazing good fortune of having a talented architect as House Chair. In that role, **Dan Marshall** coordinates volunteers and paid contractors. We are grateful for the attention given to our building.

We are grateful for the widespread support of the appeal to the Cantorial fund. The goal was reached. How reassuring that many members voluntarily increased their dues.

Not all support is financial. Volunteers are needed. You will be hearing from the new Adult Education Chair. Please contact me if you will chair the Social Action Committee. Members are also needed for the Social Action Committee.

We are grateful the State of Israel became a reality during our lifetime. Bittersweet is seeing members of our congregation make *aliyah*. We miss them. Our connection with *Eretz Yisrael* is strengthened with each friend who becomes a part of our land. The new Israel Committee has a wonderful Chair, **Rachel Bloomberg**, and members who will shape this important part of our heritage regarding *Eretz Yisrael*. A grant from USCJ is available to us now that we have an active committee on Israel. Let me know how you wish to volunteer your time to CKI.

Some of you may not be receiving email from CKI: the beautiful emails regarding events at CKI Brad Burkner sends, SHUL NEWS with funeral and *shiva* information, plus other synagogue reminders the President sends. Please call the CKI office with your email contact information so we may better communicate with you.

We are grateful to the area Jews who started our congregation in 1892. Thanks to the Dream Committee organized in 1940, who in 1958 fulfilled their dream by dedicating the building we now enjoy. On Sunday afternoon, November 14, the Grand Dames of CKI will be honored at a fundraiser chaired by **Helen Lindow**. Above all, this will be a time of togetherness even as it raises funds to maintain our building.

Because we do not raise funds on *Shabbat*, it has become a long standing tradition of Jewish congregations to raise funds on *Yom Kippur*. Because fundraising on the solemn day of *Yom Kippur* seems strange to some, I asked Rabbi Kohn to put this into perspective. It is not enough to repent in our hearts. We repent by doing good works. Repentance is not about us. Repentance is about *tikkun olam*, about repairing the world. Repentance is for those around us.

Charity begins at home. In order for Congregation Kneseth Israel in Elgin, Illinois to continue the long-standing tradition of supporting the greater Elgin, Chicago, and world community, we must raise \$30,000 to replace the boiler that heats our building. Due to the generosity of **Mark and Robin Seigle** and the **Estate of Lora Seigle**, half of the amount has been raised. The rest of us must raise the balance so we can heat our building this season.

Tithing is central to Jewish laws. In our time, Jews tend to associate tithing with Christian denominations. Tithing began nearly 5,771 years ago with Abraham and is mentioned

throughout the *Torah*. As you examine the donation sector of your family budget, consider CKI. To facilitate donating, credit payments can be made by going to the CKI website.

Aliyahs are a significant portion of the CKI budget. Please make your *aliyah* pledge at the highest level realistic for your family. In recent articles criticizing the high cost of being Jewish, something is omitted. When we contribute time, when we study, when we attend services, and when we participate in events, we come to feel what it means to be a member of "the chosen people". It is joyous work.

In the year 5771, let us grow from our tradition of GRATITUDE, STUDY, PRAYER, AND LOVE FOR THE LAND OF ISRAEL.
