## **Congregation Kneseth Israel to Host Passover Seder**

Congregation Kneseth Israel (CKI) will be hosting a Community Seder on Tuesday, March 26th, at 6:30 pm. The Seder will be held at the synagogue which is located at 330 Division Street in Elgin. CKI's Rabbi, Margaret Frisch Klein states, "Passover is a deeply significant holiday for the Jewish people. It is also an important time of the year for many other people and faith groups as well. The celebration of freedom following a period of oppression makes this holiday a universal experience." Rabbi Klein, along with others, will be leading the service which takes place around a festive meal.

According to Anita Hornung, organizer for the event, " We are very pleased to be able offer this Seder to those in the Jewish Community who are not currently affiliated with a synagogue and may not have family in the area. We also welcome those who, although not Jewish, wish to experience this lovely service."
